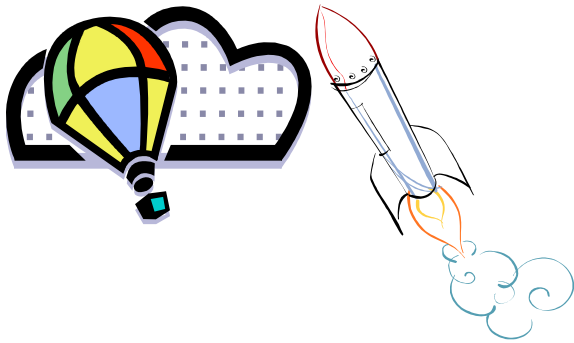
1. Canned Soup/ Pasta (20oz or Less)
